The Volunteers of America Supportive Services for Veteran Families Program (SSVF) provides advocacy, case management and temporary financial assistance including but not limited to:

- **Paid motel stays while searching for permanent housing during COVID-19 VA protocol**
- Security deposits and rental assistance
- Utility deposits and utility help
- Rental application fees
- Childcare assistance
- Auto repair assistance
- Emergency supplies
- Monthly local bus passes
- Housing Search
- Connection to Community Resources
- VA and Public Benefit connection
- Health, Mental Health & Dental Care
- Budgeting / Credit Counseling
- Employment Search
- Clothes, shoes, tools and licenses/certifications for employment
- **The VA Returning Home Program:** Bus, train and plane tickets provided to Veterans to relocate for the purposes of securing verifiable permanent housing or employment offers throughout the U.S.
- **The VA Rapid Resolution Program:** Case management and limited financial help for family members or friends of Veterans who are willing to provide temporary housing to Veterans actively seeking to secure permanent housing and/or employment.
- **Service-Directed Housing Intervention:** Advocacy without financial assistance to help Veterans remain in housing or to help Veterans search for and secure permanent housing and/or employment.

QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO*:

- Veterans and Veteran households who are currently homeless or facing risk of homelessness (eviction)
- Veteran eligibility as determined by, DD-214, HINQs, VA ID, and/or SQUARES II.
- Income equals 0 - 50% of the Area Median Income for household size
- Eligible for Veterans Administration Health Benefits -OR- Served in the Reserve/National Guard called to active service under federal orders with tour of duty completed. -AND/OR- Served at least 1 day of active duty with any discharge other than Dishonorable
